

Senate Resolution 668

ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

1 Designating a portion of SR 101 in Paulding County as the John D. Smith Highway; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, from 1900 until his death, John D. Smith lived and raised an outstanding family
4 in the Concord Church Community of Paulding County; and

5 WHEREAS, John D. Smith was known and loved throughout the community as a good
6 Christian man and community leader; and

7 WHEREAS, many generations of his descendants have lived within 1/2 mile of the Smith
8 homeplace and have made numerous contributions to the economic, social, and religious
9 lives of their community; and

10 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that the contributions of John D. Smith and his
11 family be properly recognized.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 GEORGIA that SR 101 in Paulding County from Harmony Road at the Concord Baptist
14 Church southward to the Carroll County line is hereby designated as the John D. Smith
15 Highway.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
17 directed to erect and maintain signs so identifying such highway.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
19 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Department of Transportation.
