A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 12-7-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to best
- 2 management practices for land-disturbing activities, so as to provide for a proportional
- 3 increase in the required stream buffer width as the width of the stream increases; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 12-7-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to best management
- 8 practices for land-disturbing activities, is amended by redesignating subsections (c) and (d)
- 9 as subsections (d) and (e), respectively, and by inserting a new subsection (c) to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 "(c) The 25 foot minimum buffer requirement of paragraph (15) of subsection (b) of this
- 12 Code section and the 50 foot minimum buffer requirement of paragraph (16) of subsection
- 13 (b) of this Code section shall be adjusted to increase automatically as the width of the
- stream increases and in a corresponding proportion as the stream increases."

15 SECTION 2.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
