A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Georgia Peach Festival and inviting the 2003 Georgia Peach Queens to
2 appear before the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the peach has long been a nationally recognized symbol for the State of
4 Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the Georgia peach industry has played a significant role in the economic growth
6 and prosperity of our state, and Georgia ranks second in the nation in the annual production
7 of peaches; and

8 WHEREAS, the Georgia Peach Festival originated in Peach County, Georgia, in 1987,
9 thanks to the inspiration of Mr. Harold Peavy, who conceived the festival for the purpose of
10 promoting Peach County, Georgia, and the peach industry; and

11 WHEREAS, this annual festival, now in its fifty-third year, celebrates Peach County's status
12 as one of the largest producers of peaches in the state; and

13 WHEREAS, in connection with this celebration, five very fine young ladies were crowned
14 as the 2003 Peach Queens, including Raelyn Buchanan, Tiny Miss Georgia Peach; Caroline
15 Carroll, Little Miss Georgia Peach; Brittany Greer, Junior Miss Georgia Peach; Lindsay
16 Schafer, Teen Miss Georgia Peach; and Katy Sulhoff, Miss Georgia Peach; and

17 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that this festival and its representatives be
18 recognized by this body.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body commend the Georgia Peach Festival for promoting the importance
21 of this agricultural product of Georgia and invite the 2003 Georgia Peach Queens to appear

1 before the House of Representatives on a date and at a time to be determined by the Speaker
2 of the House of Representatives.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
4 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Board of Directors of
5 the Georgia Peach Festival.
