A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Cherokee County Chief Magistrate Court Judge Charles Robertson; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Charles Robertson is a native Georgian and a graduate of Georgia State
4 University and the John Marshall Law School in Atlanta, has served his nation in the United
5 States military, and has served as Cherokee County Chief Magistrate Court Judge since
6 January 2001; and

7 WHEREAS, Judge Robertson is a published author of five books; and

8 WHEREAS, in his capacity as magistrate judge of Cherokee County, he has been responsible
9 for dramatic improvement in court efficiency; and

10 WHEREAS, Judge Robertson's newly designed interactive magistrate court website makes
11 the court experience easier for citizens of Cherokee County; and

12 WHEREAS, the website is currently a semi-finalist for a national award of excellence
13 presented by Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government and the Council
14 for Excellence in Government and has also now been adopted by the City of New York and
15 court systems in Florida; and

16 WHEREAS, Judge Robertson is widely recognized as a leader in Cherokee County, and his
17 service to its citizens has resulted in its magistrate court system being one of the best in
18 Georgia; and

19 WHEREAS, his willingness to embrace new technology has made him a leader amongst all
20 magistrate judges and his dedication to the principles of law has made his court stand out for
21 its fairness and effectiveness.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body commend Cherokee County Chief Magistrate Court Judge Charles
3 Robertson for his many contributions to the citizens of Cherokee County and the State of
