

## Senate Resolution 863

## A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia and the Department of  
2 Education to work together to find incentives and create avenues to encourage student  
3 participation as poll workers; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, many Georgia counties have stated the difficulty of finding the needed number  
5 of poll workers on election day; and

6 WHEREAS, several general bills proposing legislation to address the lack of poll workers  
7 in certain geographic regions have been introduced in the General Assembly validating that  
8 a problem finding poll workers exists; and

9 WHEREAS, in 2001, the General Assembly enacted Senate Bill 213 which was approved  
10 by the Governor on April 18, 2001 (Act No. 166; Ga. L. 2001, p. 269), which called for the  
11 Twenty-first Century Voting Commission to work with the Board of Regents of the  
12 University System of Georgia and the Department of Education to increase student  
13 participation as poll workers or in other areas of the election process; and

14 WHEREAS, there has been no program established nor any attempt to formulate a program  
15 by the Board of Regents or the Department of Education to increase student participation in  
16 the election process in the three years since the bill's enactment; and

17 WHEREAS, the educational benefits to the students are many if students participate in the  
18 election process as poll workers or in another capacity; and

19 WHEREAS, certain precinct level changes to the election procedures have been stymied  
20 partly due to concerns as to whether poll workers could handle the additional workload.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the Board of Regents of  
22 the University System of Georgia and the Department of Education are urged to work

1 together to craft policies that will increase student participation as poll workers or in other  
2 areas of the election process.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
4 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to each member of the Board of Regents  
5 of the University System of Georgia and the State Board of Education.
