

Senate Bill 597

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 32-10-65 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 fixing, revising, charging, and collecting tolls, and use and disposition of tolls generally, so  
3 as to exempt persons operating motorcycles from being charged a toll on any toll road; to  
4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 32-10-65 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fixing,  
8 revising, charging, and collecting tolls, is amended by striking said Code section in its  
9 entirety and inserting in its place the following:

10 "32-10-65.

11 The authority is authorized to fix, revise, charge, and collect tolls for the use of each  
12 project. The authority shall not collect a toll from any person operating a motorcycle on  
13 any toll road. Such tolls shall be so fixed and adjusted as to carry out and perform the  
14 terms and provisions of any resolution, trust indenture, or contract with or for the benefit  
15 of bondholders; and such tolls shall not be subject to supervision or regulation by any other  
16 commission, board, bureau, or agency of the state. The use and disposition of tolls and  
17 revenues shall be subject to the provisions of the resolution authorizing the issuance of  
18 such bonds or of the trust indenture securing the same, if there are any."

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
