A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise  
3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of  
4 adjournment for the 2004 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of March 4,  
5 2004, through March 15, 2004, shall be as follows:

- 6 Thursday, March 4 . . . . . in session for legislative day 29
- 7 Friday, March 5 . . . . . in adjournment
- 8 Saturday, March 6 . . . . . in adjournment
- 9 Sunday, March 7 . . . . . in adjournment
- 10 Monday, March 8 . . . . . in adjournment
- 11 Tuesday, March 9 . . . . . in session for legislative day 30
- 12 Wednesday, March 10 . . . . . in adjournment
- 13 Thursday, March 11 . . . . . in adjournment
- 14 Friday, March 12 . . . . . in session for legislative day 31
- 15 Saturday, March 13 . . . . . in adjournment
- 16 Sunday, March 14 . . . . . in adjournment
- 17 Monday, March 15 . . . . . in session for legislative day 32

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after March 15, 2004, the periods of adjournment  
19 of the 2004 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General  
20 Assembly, except that for the remainder of the 2004 regular session, unless otherwise  
21 provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close of the  
22 legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall  
23 reconvene on the following Monday.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for  
25 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the  
26 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
