A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the William Ira (W.I.) Still, Jr., Highway; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, William Ira (W.I.) Still, Jr., was an esteemed and highly valued member of the
3 community of Loganville, Georgia, in Gwinnett County; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was born on January 21, 1910, in the Youth community of Walton County;
5 married Emmie Sue Lacey from Stephens County; and established a general mercantile store
6 in Loganville with the Lacey family during 1932; and
- 7 WHEREAS, this well-known store operated with great success over 50 years serving the
8 Loganville area citizens by selling farming equipment, tools, fuel, groceries, produce, and
9 various and sundry household items; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the store was a special community gathering place where local families
11 shopped, shared community news, and exchanged ideas and opinions on the events of the
12 day, and it generated a significant influence on the local economy and the lives of residents;
13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, William Ira (W.I.) Still, Jr., loved his community and served it well until his
15 death, and it is appropriate that he be remembered and honored for his public service.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 GEORGIA that the portion of SR 10 in Gwinnett County that runs between Rosebud Road
18 and the Walton County line be designated the William Ira (W.I.) Still, Jr., Highway and the
19 Department of Transportation is directed to place and maintain appropriate markers.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
21 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the commissioner of
22 transportation and the family of William Ira Still, Jr.
