2 WHEREAS, William R. Killian was appointed to the superior court bench in the Brunswick

- 6 WHEREAS, he served in the U.S. Army in the European Theater during World War II, and

7 after the war he graduated from the University of Georgia Law School in 1944, and practiced

- 8 law in Brunswick from 1947 until his appointment to the bench in 1977; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he served as the judge of the Recorder's Court of the City of Brunswick and as
- 10 a U.S. Commissioner for the Brunswick Division of the U.S. District Court for the Southern
- 11 District of Georgia, after which he represented Glynn County in the General Assembly from
- 12 1955 through 1964; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Judge Killian is a member of the St. Simons Presbyterian Church, and he and
- 14 his lovely wife, Peggy Harper Killian, have three children, Bill Killian, Jr., Robert Killian,
- 15 and Marie Franklin Killian, and four grandchildren; and
- WHEREAS, it is only right and proper that this great Georgian be honored and commended. 16
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that the members of this body commend Judge William R. Killian for his service to his 18 19 community, this state, and the nation.
