12 Atlanta Police Officer and an Army Reservist, and he also served as a teacher in the Fulton
13 County school system; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Smith was an active churchgoer and at the time of his death was a member
15 of Greenforest Community Baptist Church in Decatur, Georgia, serving as an usher, a
16 Sunday school teacher, and a trustee; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the memories he leaves behind will be cherished forever by his wonderful
18 family and many loving friends.
