A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise
 3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of
 4 adjournment for the 2004 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of
 5 March 15, 2004, through March 22, 2004, shall be as follows:

6	Monday, March 15	in session for legislative day 32
7	Tuesday, March 16	in adjournment
8	Wednesday, March 17	in session for legislative day 33
9	Thursday, March 18	in adjournment
10	Friday, March 19	in session for legislative day 34
11	Saturday, March 20	in adjournment
12	Sunday, March 21	in adjournment
13	Monday, March 22	in session for legislative day 35

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after March 22, 2004, the periods of adjournment
 15 of the 2004 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General
 16 Assembly, except that for the remainder of the 2004 regular session, unless otherwise
 17 provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close of the
 18 legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall
 19 reconvene on the following Monday.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for
 21 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the
 22 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
