

Senate Resolution 858

**ADOPTED SENATE**

**A RESOLUTION**

1 Authorizing the Governor by executive order to establish local redevelopment commissions  
2 for the purpose of developing and directing redevelopment plans in accordance with the  
3 "Base Closure Community Redevelopment and Homeless Assistance Act of 1994"; to  
4 provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 WHEREAS, the Governor is authorized by Code Section 50-2-27 to accept for this state  
6 retrocession of jurisdiction by the United States over land owned by the United States within  
7 the boundaries of this state; and

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 50-16-61, the Governor has general  
9 supervision over all property of this state.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
11 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

**SECTION 1.**

12 The Governor by executive order may establish local redevelopment commissions with such  
13 powers as may be necessary, proper, or convenient, as the local redevelopment authority, to  
14 develop and direct redevelopment plans in accordance with the "Base Closure Community  
15 Redevelopment and Homeless Assistance Act of 1994," and implementing federal  
16 regulations and policies and related federal statutes, including, without limitation,  
17 designation of participating government and private members of such commissions. The  
18 commissions shall be composed of eight members. The Governor shall appoint four  
19 members. The Committee on Assignments of the Senate shall appoint two members and the  
20 Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two members.

**SECTION 2.**

22 This resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its  
23 becoming law without such approval.

1 **SECTION 3.**

2 All laws and parts of law in conflict with this resolution are repealed.
