A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Bank of Hancock County and congratulating it on the occasion of its 100th
2 anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on October 18, 1904, Greene County's Bank of Siloam was chartered by the
4 State of Georgia with a capital stock of \$25,000.00; and

5 WHEREAS, the Bank of Siloam was granted its request for a change of its charter name and
6 on October 8, 1941, became the Bank of Hancock County and began business in a rented
7 building on West Broad Street in Sparta; and

8 WHEREAS, on July 1, 1944, the Bank of Hancock County began accepting savings deposits
9 from customers; and

10 WHEREAS, in 1953 the bank purchased the property formerly occupied by K. F. Motors
11 located at 321 East Broad Street and in 1967 relocated to that site where it remains today;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, since that time the bank has grown considerably and, through its dedicated and
14 dependable employees and management, continues to grow; and

15 WHEREAS, the Bank of Hancock County is locally owned and operated, offering its
16 customers excellent service, up-to-date technology, and modern convenience, and doing its
17 part to help the local economy grow.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body commend the Bank of Hancock County for its dutiful service to
20 the residents and business community of Hancock County and congratulate it on the occasion
21 of its 100th anniversary.
