A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Old Pleasant Hill Baptist Church and its schoolhouse restoration project;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Old Pleasant Hill Baptist Church has been a fixture in its community for over
4 100 years; and

5 WHEREAS, the church will dedicate its newly restored, over a century old schoolhouse and
6 will commemorate the occasion on the Old Pleasant Hill Baptist Church's annual Family and
7 Friends Day; and

8 WHEREAS, many students have toiled over their studies in this building; and dedicated
9 teachers have helped quench their thirst for learning and stand as a testament to the
10 importance of education and knowledge; and

11 WHEREAS, many of the old schoolhouse's students and faculty have left this world, but the
12 education instilled by its teachers in the minds of their pupils serves as the foundation this
13 community and state are built on; and

14 WHEREAS, the schoolhouse was restored as a result of the time and labor of many dedicated
15 souls and it will serve as a window into the past and as a historical guidepost for the future
16 generations in our community.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body recognize the Old Pleasant Hill Baptist Church for its honorable
19 and noble actions in restoring this historical schoolhouse and landmark.
