## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Boy Scout Troop 383; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America have a long and distinguished history of service to  
3 their communities, of training boys in outdoor skills and first aid, and of doing good deeds  
4 for others; and

5 WHEREAS, Boy Scout Troop 383 of Whigham, Georgia, has honored and distinguished  
6 itself by reaching a level of achievement rarely seen but by the very best of Boy Scout  
7 Troops; and

8 WHEREAS, in its eight-year history, the leaders and members of Troop 383, with the  
9 sponsorship and support of the Whigham Community Club, have had the extraordinary  
10 privilege of witnessing ten of its members succeed in attaining the rank of Eagle Scout, the  
11 Boy Scouts' highest level of distinction; and

12 WHEREAS, these ten Eagle Scouts listed below represent 20 percent of the troop's  
13 membership and contrasts to the national average of 2 percent per troop:
