A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Cori Hill as a University System of Georgia Outstanding Scholar on Academic
2 Recognition Day; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Cori Hill is the Savannah State University Outstanding Scholar for 2004, having
4 attained the distinction of earning the highest grade point average and representing
5 excellence in academic achievement and personal development; and

6 WHEREAS, Academic Recognition Day was begun in 1987 as a celebration of individual
7 academic achievement and recognition of those students who exemplify that which is best
8 about the University System of Georgia and its institutions, the commitment to excellence
9 in scholarship, and a lifelong quest for knowledge and understanding; and

10 WHEREAS, the 34 institutions of the University System of Georgia are valuable resources
11 for the people of this state, enhancing the intellectual, economic, social, civic, and cultural
12 well-being of the communities in which they are located and the entire state; and

13 WHEREAS, Georgia's higher education system is dedicated to the goal of providing quality
14 education to all and fostering the realization of each person's fullest potential, and it is most
15 appropriate to honor the Outstanding Scholar at each institution.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize and commend Cori Hill as the Savannah State University Outstanding Scholar for
18 2004 and convey their congratulations and best wishes.
