1 Commending Michael Alan Frisch; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Michael Alan Frisch of Troop 555 has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the
3 most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and

10 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
11 of immense benefit throughout his life; and

12 WHEREAS, only two of every 100 boys who join Cub Scouts achieve the rank of Eagle
13 Scout; and

14 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
15 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
16 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize the outstanding
18 accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body commend and congratulate Michael Alan Frisch on achieving the
21 rank of Eagle Scout.
