

ADOPTED

1 Senators Johnson of the 1st and Meyer von Bremen of the 12th offered the following
2 amendment:

3 Amend the Senate Natural Resources and the Environment substitute to SB 524 by inserting
4 between "entered" and "upon" on line 6 of page 1 "by an appropriate superior court".

5 By striking from lines 17 through 22 of page 1, lines 12 through 16 of page 2, and lines 30
6 through 34 of page 2 the following:

7 "Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the filing of such petition by
8 persons other than the permittee, or person to whom the order or action is directed, shall
9 not automatically stay such permit, order, or action; provided, however, the administrative
10 law judge may grant a stay of the enforcement of such permit, order, or action upon
11 appropriate terms for good cause shown."

12 and inserting in their place the following:

13 "Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the filing of such petition by
14 persons other than the permittee, or person to whom the order or action is directed, shall
15 not automatically stay such permit, order, or action. Pursuant to Code Section 9-11-65, an
16 appropriate superior court may enjoin a party from activities authorized by any such
17 permit, order, or action while such permit, order, or action is under review by an
18 administrative law judge."
