2 WHEREAS, Elizabeth Fox-Genovese is one of only two Georgians serving on the Governing

3 Council of the National Endowment for the Humanities; and

4 WHEREAS, since 1990, she has given over 150 invited lectures to university audiences

5 around the country; and

6 WHEREAS, she has served as general editor of four volumes of curricular materials for the

7 Organization of American Historians on American women's history; and

8 WHEREAS, Elizabeth Fox-Genovese has served on a variety of public advisory boards that

9 reflect her interdisciplinary interests, including those of the Center for Human Life and

10 Bioethics, the Center for Religion and Democracy, and the Society in American Ideals and

11 Institutions at Princeton; and

12 WHEREAS, Elizabeth Fox-Genovese has shown steadfast dedication to teaching and13 mentoring of university students, both undergraduate and graduate; and

WHEREAS, she has enhanced the understanding and appreciation of the humanities forcountless Georgians; and

16 WHEREAS, in receiving the National Humanities Medal, Elizabeth Fox-Genovese has

17 brought honor to her adopted State of Georgia and joins a select number of distinguished

18 individuals who have set the highest standards for American cultural achievement; and

19 WHEREAS, Elizabeth Fox-Genovese has performed an incalculable public service through

20 her extraordinary powers of creativity and vision in preserving, interpreting, and expanding

21 this nation's cultural heritage; and

- 4 cultural contributions to the humanities, the State of Georgia, and the nation.
