

Senate Bill 628

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a board of education of Madison County, approved March 24,
2 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 4698), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 25, 2002
3 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4421), so as to make technical changes in said 2002 amendatory Act; to
4 provide for the manner and time of election for members of the board; to ratify and confirm,
5 to the maximum extent possible, any election previously held under the provisions of such
6 amendatory Act; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
7 purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 An Act creating a board of education of Madison County, approved March 24, 1988
11 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 4698), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 25, 2002
12 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4421), is amended by striking subsections (b) and (c) of Section 4 and
13 inserting in lieu thereof new subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:

14 "(b) The first members of the reconstituted board of education of Madison County from
15 Education Districts 1 and 4 shall be elected at the nonpartisan general election held in
16 conjunction with the state-wide general primary in 2002. Such members shall take office
17 on January 1 following their election for terms of four years and until their successors are
18 elected and qualified.

19 (c) The first members of the reconstituted board of education of Madison County from
20 Education Districts 2, 3, and 5 shall be elected at the nonpartisan general election held in
21 conjunction with the state-wide general primary in 2004. Such members shall take office
22 on January 1 following their election for terms of four years and until their successors are
23 elected and qualified."
