- 1 Recognizing and saluting Mr. Robert J. Taft; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Trooper Robert J. Taft first became an esteemed member of the Georgia State
3 Patrol in February of 1942; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he served the Georgia State Patrol with honor and distinction for 27 years and
5 11 months and retired on August 31, 1970; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served the state patrol as trooper, corporal, sergeant, lieutenant, and captain
7 and at the time of his retirement was a captain in the patrol's Special Services Division; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Trooper Robert J. Taft is widely recognized as the oldest and most senior
9 former member of the Georgia State Patrol living today and thus it is both fitting and proper
10 that he be appropriately recognized.
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
12 the members of this body recognize Mr. Robert J. Taft and salute him on his many great
13 years of service to this state.
