4 and was raised in Grand Forks, North Dakota; and

5 WHEREAS, he graduated from Central High School in 1988 and attended the University of
6 Minnesota, Crookston; and

7 WHEREAS, he entered the United States Army on June 18, 1992, as a logistical specialist
8 and attended basic training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, and advanced individual training
9 at Fort Lee, Virginia; and

10 WHEREAS, in his 11 year career with the army, he served at Fort Bragg, North Carolina;
11 Landstuhl, Germany; Fort Benning, Georgia; South Korea; and Fort Campbell, Kentucky;

13 WHEREAS, he was deployed to Nicaragua on a peace keeping mission and to Iraq where
14 he spent a year serving in Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

15 WHEREAS, for his devoted, skilled, and disciplined service to his country, the United States
16 Army, and his fellow soldiers, Sergeant Robinson has earned three U. S. Army
17 Commendation Medals; two U. S. Army Achievement Medals; three Good Conduct Medals;
18 a National Defense Ribbon; an Army Service Ribbon; an Overseas Ribbon; and two
19 Certificates of Achievement.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body commend and salute Sergeant Vincent LaGeorge Robinson, Jr., for

1 his selfless service in defense of his nation and the people of Iraq and congratulate him upon
