

1 Senator Price of the 56th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend the Senate State and Local Governmental Operations Committee substitute to SB 500
3 by inserting "(a)" before "Until" on line 19 on page 2 and striking line 28 on page 2 and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 "voting equipment or other certifying body or entity.

6 (b) The Secretary of State shall test or cause to be tested and certify such printers in
7 accordance with Code Section 21-2-379.2. In so doing, the Secretary of State shall have
8 the authority to promulgate reasonable rules and regulations for the purpose of certifying
9 such printers.

10 (c) Printers that are regularly and routinely used in commercial applications such as
11 automatic teller machines and similar devices for providing receipts to customers in
12 everyday commercial transactions shall not require hardware testing.

13 (d) When a direct recording electronic voting system has been previously approved by the
14 Secretary of State, the improvement or change of such system through the addition or
15 attachment of a printer to provide a permanent paper record with a manual audit capacity
16 for the votes cast by each individual voter that does not impair the accuracy, efficiency, or
17 capacity of the system shall not require a reexamination or reapproval of such system or
18 of its kind; provided, however, that the Secretary of State may require the testing of the
19 software associated with such printer and the interface between the direct recording
20 electronic voting equipment and the printer."
