A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Casey Craig; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Casey Craig of Monroe, Georgia, was one of four Olympian cyclists from
3 Georgia who attended the World Special Olympics in Dublin, Ireland, on June 28, 2003; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Casey was only one of four cyclists who won a gold medal for the 10K road
5 race at the Special Olympics; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Casey won a silver medal for the 10K time trial race on June 26, 2003; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Casey is a native Georgian who grew up in Monroe, Walton County, Georgia,
8 and is in the eighth grade at Carver Middle School in Monroe; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Casey still finds time from her cycling to lead a normal 15 year old's life by
10 spending time with friends, listening to music, and playing basketball with her brother; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Casey has received invaluable training and advice from her coach at Carver
12 Middle School, Ms. Kim Wages, and her Olympic cycling coach, Mr. Lee Tidmore; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it takes a tremendous amount of work and dedication to achieve such a lofty
14 award and she has earned this honor through persistence as well as natural talent.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 commend Casey Craig for being a gold medal winner at the 2003 World Special Olympic
17 Games and wish her every success in that endeavor and in the future.
