A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Slosheye Trail Big Pig Jig; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Dooly County Chamber of Commerce is sponsoring the twenty-third
3 Slosheye Trail Big Pig Jig in Vienna, Georgia, on October 1 and October 2, 2004; and

4 WHEREAS, this unparalleled "Cadillac of Barbecue Contests" attracts teams from across the
5 southeastern United States who match their culinary craftsmanship and highly refined skills
6 in the consummate art of pig cookery and the creation of one of the most exquisite, treasured,
7 and relished foods in Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, this event, which has grown in magnitude each year since its inception, has
9 become one of the Southeast's most widely anticipated and popular annual festivals and was
10 recognized as the 1999 "Best Georgia Festival" by the Georgia Festivals and Events
11 Association; and

12 WHEREAS, the General Assembly designated this magnificent event as the "official state
13 pork barbecue championship cookoff" in 1997; and

14 WHEREAS, the overall grand champion of the contest, whose tender, succulent, and peerless
15 pork preparation is deemed most delightful to the senses, pleasing to the palate, and
16 matchlessly mouth watering above all others, shall be chosen on Saturday, October 2, 2004,
17 and shall represent this state in the 2004 World Barbecue Cooking Championship.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body recognizes the
19 Slosheye Trail Big Pig Jig and commends the organizers for going whole hog in broadening
20 the scope of the event.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
2 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Dooly County Chamber of
