## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Georgia's 224th Joint Communications Support Squadron;  
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, no Georgia National Guard unit has been on the front lines during the two-year  
4 War on Terror longer than Georgia's 224th Joint Communications Support Squadron from  
5 Brunswick; and

6 WHEREAS, the unit was selected by the Special Operations Command to provide command  
7 and control to the theater commander for the war in Afghanistan; and

8 WHEREAS, Georgia's 224th Joint Communications Support Squadron planned and designed  
9 the command, control, communications, and computer architect systems supporting  
10 Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom to battlefield commanders in  
11 Afghanistan and several countries throughout the Middle East; and

12 WHEREAS, the unit is commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Floyd Harbin.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
14 the members of this body commend Georgia's 224th Joint Communications Support  
15 Squadron for more than two years of dedicated service in the War on Terror and recognize  
16 its outstanding contributions to Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
18 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Georgia's 224th Joint
