

1 The Senate Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee offered the following  
2 amendment:

3 Amend HB 274 by striking line 7 of page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "served during certain wars; to provide for a minimum number of applications before  
5 issuance of such special and distinctive license plates; to provide for related matters; to  
6 repeal conflicting laws; and for".

7 By striking line 9 of page 6 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 "motor vehicles as prescribed in Article 2 of this chapter, except that no special license  
9 plate shall be issued for retired veterans of the National Guard or persons who served in the  
10 Global War on Terrorism until applications have been received from at least 500 persons."
