

House Bill 1820

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To provide that certain officials of Columbia County who have served at least 15 years in
2 office may, upon leaving office, continue to participate in the county health insurance
3 program by paying the total cost of such participation; to provide for related matters; to
4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 Members of the Board of Commissioners of Columbia County; the Clerk of the Superior
8 Court of Columbia County; the Judge of the Probate Court of Columbia County; the Sheriff
9 of Columbia County; the Tax Receiver, Tax Collector, and Tax Commissioner of Columbia
10 County; the Coroner of Columbia County; and the Chief Magistrate of Columbia County
11 shall be entitled after leaving office to continue to participate in and be covered by the health
12 insurance plan provided by the county for county officers and employees, provided that such
13 officer must have served at least 15 years in such office and provided, further, that such
14 officer pays the total costs of such participation including both the employee and employer
15 premiums associated with such participation.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
