provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of
adjournment for the 2004 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of
March 22, 2004, through March 24, 2004, shall be as follows:

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after March 24, 2004, the periods of adjournment 10 of the 2004 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General 11 Assembly except that for the remainder of the 2004 regular session, unless otherwise 12 provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close of the 13 legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall 14 reconvene on the following Monday.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
