## ADOPTED

- 1 Senator Harp of the 16th offered the following amendment:
- Amend HB 1263 by redesignating Sections 2 and 3 as Sections 3 and 4, respectively, and by
  striking lines 1 through 3 on page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 4 "To amend Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance, so as
- 5 to authorize service of orders and notices by electronic mail; to define the term 'claim
- 6 against a policy'; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal".
- 7 By striking lines 7 and 8 on page 1 and inserting the following:
- 8 "Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance, is amended by
  9 adding a new subsection (d) to Code Section 33-2-10, relating to issuance and service of
  10 orders and notices, to read as follows:
- 11 '(d) In addition to the service provisions set forth in subsection (c) of this Code section, 12 any order of the Commissioner issued to multiple recipients in the form of a general 13 directive, data call, or bulletin may be served by sending it by electronic mail, so that 14 receipt is acknowledged by the recipient, to the electronic mail address on record in the 15 Commissioner's office. The Commissioner shall also post such general directive, data call, 16 or bulletin contemporaneously on the department's website '
- 16 or bulletin contemporaneously on the department's website.'
  - **SECTION 2.**

Said title is further amended by striking subsection (b) of Code Section 33-24-46 of the
Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to cancellation and nonrenewal of certain
property insurance policies,".
