

ADOPTED

1 Senator Stokes of the 43rd offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HB 1347 by striking line 1 of page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 "To amend Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
4 relating to children and youth services, so as to provide for availability of information in
5 child welfare agencies relating to recall notices on unsafe child care products; to amend
6 Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,".

7 By redesignating Sections 1, 2, and 3 as Sections 2, 3, and 4, respectively, and by inserting
8 a new Section 1 to read as follows:

9 **"SECTION 1.**

10 Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
11 children and youth services, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

12 '49-5-23.

13 (a) Any agency, department, or office that regulates child welfare agencies shall make
14 available to such child welfare agencies at the time of application for initial or renewal
15 certification or licensure information concerning contacting the U. S. Consumer Product
16 Safety Commission to obtain recall notices on unsafe child and infant products.

17 (b) Child welfare agencies shall post the phone number and website of the U. S. Consumer
18 Product Safety Commission in a location visible to parents and visitors. The notice shall
19 also advise such parents and visitors on how to obtain recall notices on unsafe child and
20 infant products."
