1 To provide that the tax commissioner of DeKalb County shall retain a specified percentage

of educational funds collected by said officer and remit the same to the governing authority
of DeKalb County to reimburse the county for the cost of collecting school taxes; to provide

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 The tax commissioner of DeKalb County shall remit all educational funds collected by said

9 officer to the Board of Education of DeKalb County, except that 1.25 percent of the funds

10 collected shall be retained by the tax commissioner and remitted to the governing authority

- 11 of DeKalb County to reimburse the county for the cost of collecting school taxes.
- SECTION 2.
 It is the intention of this Act to reduce the amount authorized by subsection (a) of Code
 Section 48-5-404 of the O.C.G.A. as reimbursement to counties for the collection of school
 taxes, and this Act is pursuant to the specific authority of Paragraph III of Section VI of
 Article VIII of the Constitution of the State of Georgia.

SECTION 3.

- 18 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2005.

- 20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
