

Senate Resolution 998

#### A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the President, the Federal Trade Commission, the U.S. Department of Energy, the  
2 U.S. Department of Justice, and Congress to address the rising price of gasoline; and for  
3 other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the nation is witnessing the fastest rate increase in gasoline prices in 50 years  
5 with the average cost of gasoline being \$1.77 per gallon in the nation and \$1.59 per gallon  
6 in Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, the increase in gasoline prices furthers the economic recession that the State of  
8 Georgia currently suffers and creates a substantial financial hardship on the people of the  
9 State of Georgia.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the President, the Federal  
11 Trade Commission, the U.S. Department of Energy, the U.S. Department of Justice, and  
12 Congress are urged to address and investigate the rising price of gasoline.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
14 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the President, the Chairman of the  
15 Federal Trade Commission, the Secretary of Energy, the U.S. Attorney General, and each  
16 member of the Georgia Congressional Delegation.
