A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 50-18-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 public records exempted from inspection by members of the general public, so as to provide  
3 an exemption for certain records including identifying information for minors; to provide for  
4 disclosure of records with such information redacted; to provide for conflicts of law; to  
5 provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 50-18-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to public records  
9 exempted from inspection by members of the general public, is amended in subsection (a)  
10 by striking "or" at the end of paragraph (15); by striking the period at the end of paragraph  
11 (16) and inserting in lieu thereof "; or"; and by inserting a new paragraph to be designated  
12 paragraph (17) to read as follows:

13 "(17) Records of athletic or recreational programs, available through the state or a  
14 political subdivision of the state, that include information identifying a child or children  
15 12 years of age or under by name, address, telephone number, or emergency contact,  
16 unless such identifying information has been redacted."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
19 without such approval.

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
