A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Darlene Wise Green and her valuable contributions to Young People on the
2 Move, Inc. and inviting her to appear before the House of Representatives; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Darlene Wise Green is married to Don W. Green and is the mother of three
5 daughters, Shantelle Burks, Natasha Green, and Dawn Green; and

6 WHEREAS, upon the closing of the Naval Supply Center in Charleston, South Carolina, in
7 1995, she relocated her family to Kings Bay, Georgia, to work at the Trident Refit Facility
8 where she serves as an accounting technician; and

9 WHEREAS, in 1998, noting a lack of constructive activities and programs directed at young
10 people in the county, Darlene and a group of concerned women met to discuss what could
11 be done to save the area youth from a future of teenage pregnancy, single parenthood,
12 dropping out of high school, and becoming an underskilled and unemployed adult; and

13 WHEREAS, the meeting served as a catalyst leading to the formation of Young People On
14 The Move, Inc., a diversified organization founded on the principle of self-sufficiency; and

15 WHEREAS, the youth in Camden County have benefited immeasurably from the services
16 provided by Young People On The Move, Inc., that focus on developing community service,
17 giving, and sharing skills that are an integral part of child development; and

18 WHEREAS, to reach the young people in the area, Young People On The Move, Inc., meets
19 at various locations such as the local library, schools, churches, and community facilities and,
20 in the future, hopes to open a county-wide youth center; and

1 WHEREAS, many Young People On The Move, Inc., participants have received
2 scholarships to further their education and become better citizens, striving to give back to
3 their community; and

4 WHEREAS, Young People On The Move, Inc., is proud of the fact that it has been certified
5 as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
7 the members of this body recognize Darlene Wise Green and her valuable contributions to
8 Young People On The Move, Inc., Camden County, and the young people of this state.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Darlene Wise Green is invited to appear before the
10 House of Representatives at a date and time to be designated by the Speaker of the House of
11 Representatives.
