A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Nathan Jones on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on March 8, 2004, Nathan Jones, a member of Boy Scout Troop 55 in Houston,
3 Texas, received the Eagle Scout Award, which since 1911 has been the symbol of the highest
4 and most prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 5 WHEREAS, only two of every 100 boys who join Cub Scouts achieve the rank of Eagle
6 Scout; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a candidate for the rank of Eagle Scout must complete a rigorous program of
8 training and must demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques and
9 commitment to the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a scout has developed leadership
11 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
12 of immense benefit throughout his life; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in reaching this goal, Nathan Jones earned 25 merit badges, held positions of
14 leadership within his troop, successfully completed an approved Eagle Project by conducting
15 a drive for food and hygiene items on behalf of the Christian Community Service Center, and
16 successfully completed an Eagle Scout Board of Review; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Nathan Jones has brought honor to himself, his
18 family, and his troop.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 Nathan Jones is recognized and commended on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and the
21 members of this body extend their best wishes for happiness and success in future endeavors.
