1 Senator Tate of the 38th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend the Senate Health and Human Services Committee substitute to HB 1028 by inserting  
3 after "actions;" on line 10 on page 1 "to require medical malpractice insurers to base rates on  
4 experience in this state;".

5 By striking line 27 on page 16 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 "conflicting provisions of Title 51 or any other law.

8 31-46-70.

9 Each domestic, foreign, and alien insurer writing or authorized to write medical  
10 malpractice insurance in this state shall develop and establish rates based upon each  
11 individual insurer's experience in this state."
