A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Sergeant Vincent LaGeorge Robinson, Jr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Sgt. Vincent Robinson, Jr., is a native of Hempstead, New York, and was reared
3 in Grand Forks, North Dakota, where he graduated from Central High School in 1988; and

4 WHEREAS, he attended the University of Minnesota; and

5 WHEREAS, he entered the United States Army on June 18, 1992, as a Logistical Specialist;

7 WHEREAS, he attended basic training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, and advanced
8 individual training at Fort Lee, Virginia; and

9 WHEREAS, while serving at Fort Benning, Georgia, he was deployed to Nicaragua on a
10 peace keeping mission - Joint Endeavors Freedom; and

11 WHEREAS, Sgt. Robinson was also deployed for a year in Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi
12 Freedom; and

13 WHEREAS, for his valorous service, Sgt. Robinson has received three Army Commendation
14 Medals, two Army Achievement Medals, three Good Conduct Medals, a National Defense
15 Ribbon, an Army Service Overseas Ribbon, and two certificates of achievement.
