

House Bill 1461 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state administrative organization regarding revenue and taxation, so as to provide for limited circumstances under which the state revenue commissioner or an officer or employee of the Department of Revenue may disclose certain confidential taxpayer information; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state administrative organization regarding revenue and taxation, is amended by adding a new Code section immediately following Code Section 48-2-15, to be designated Code Section 48-2-15.1, to read as follows:

"48-2-15.1.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, confidential taxpayer information or records with respect to which the taxpayer has granted express written authorization to the commissioner or an officer or employee of the department may be disclosed to or discussed with another party."

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
