A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to state administrative organization regarding revenue and taxation, so as to provide
- 3 for limited circumstances under which the state revenue commissioner or an officer or
- 4 employee of the Department of Revenue may disclose certain confidential taxpayer
- 5 information; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state
- 9 administrative organization regarding revenue and taxation, is amended by adding a new
- 10 Code section immediately following Code Section 48-2-15, to be designated Code Section
- 11 48-2-15.1, to read as follows:
- 12 "48-2-15.1.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, confidential taxpayer
- information or records with respect to which the taxpayer has granted express written
- authorization to the commissioner or an officer or employee of the department may be
- disclosed to or discussed with another party."

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 19 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
