1 Commending and congratulating the Kennesaw State University women's soccer team; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Kennesaw State University women's soccer team has won the National
4 Collegiate Athletic Association's (NCAA) 2003 Division II national championship crown;

6 WHEREAS, in only its second year of existence, this outstanding team and collection of
7 talent completed its 2003 season with an amazing record of 25 wins and a single loss and
8 boasts a lifetime record of 43 wins, one tie, and one loss; and

9 WHEREAS, the team set a new NCAA Division II tournament record with an unprecedented
10 five consecutive shutout victories; and

11 WHEREAS, no doubt attributable to his team's remarkable two-year record and the expert
12 guidance he has provided them, Head Coach Rob King was named the National Coach of the
13 Year; and

14 WHEREAS, the 2003 season marks the team's second consecutive Peach Belt Conference
15 regular season and conference tournament championship; and

16 WHEREAS, for the exemplary play, athletic prowess, and team work on the field, it is
17 wholly fitting and proper that this team and its tremendous accomplishments be appropriately
