A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Stephen Wieschhaus on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Stephen Wieschhaus, a member of Boy Scout Troop 2000 in Duluth, Georgia,
4 received the Eagle Scout Award at an Eagle Scout Court of Honor Ceremony held on
5 April 24, 2004; and

6 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest and most
7 prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and

8 WHEREAS, only two of every 100 boys who join Cub Scouts achieve the rank of Eagle
9 Scout; and

10 WHEREAS, the candidate for the rank of Eagle Scout must complete a rigorous program of
11 training and must demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques and
12 commitment to the highest ideals of scouting; and

13 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a scout has developed leadership
14 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
15 of immense benefit throughout his life; and

16 WHEREAS, in order for a scout to reach this goal, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of
17 which are mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; he must hold positions of
18 leadership within his troop; he must successfully complete an approved Eagle Project; and
19 he must successfully complete an Eagle Scout Board of Review; and

20 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, he has brought honor to himself, his family,
21 and his troop.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that Stephen Wieschhaus is
2 recognized and commended on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and he is extended his
3 community's best wishes for success and happiness in future endeavors.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
5 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Stephen Wieschhaus.
