A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and recognizing Jody Alyssa Cohen on earning the Girl Scouts of America
2 Gold Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on June 4, 2004, Jody will attain the Gold Award, the highest and most
4 distinguished award conferred by the Girl Scouts of America; and

5 WHEREAS, Jody Alyssa Cohen has been a Girl Scout since 1991 and a member of
6 Troop 4625 in Gwinnett County, Georgia, since 1996; and

7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 150 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Miss
8 Cohen has ably demonstrated her leadership abilities obtained through the Girl Scout
9 program; and

10 WHEREAS, to earn the Gold Award, this exceptional young woman developed a project to
11 raise community consciousness, focusing on teens, regarding HIV and AIDS and risky
12 behaviors that may lead to their contraction; and

13 WHEREAS, this outstanding Princeton University student has truly demonstrated a
14 commitment to the scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently
15 conducted herself in a manner befitting the Gold Award; and

16 WHEREAS, in a world which seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the actions of
17 young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with particularity
18 the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend and recognize Jody Alyssa Cohen on earning the Girl Scouts of America Gold
