### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Kennesaw State University men's basketball team; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Kennesaw State University men's basketball team brought fame and honor  
3 to the school, students, faculty, and the community as it won the 2004 NCAA Division II  
4 men's basketball national title; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Kennesaw State University defeated the University of Southern Indiana on  
6 March 27, 2004, by an impressive score of 84-59; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Kennesaw State University became the first team in the state and the Peach Belt  
8 Conference to win a Division II national title; and
- 9 WHEREAS, this outstanding team compiled a remarkable season record of 35 wins and only  
10 four losses; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Terrence Hill was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player; and
- 12 WHEREAS, these exceptional athletes demonstrated remarkable ability, motivation,  
13 resilience, and teamwork and they have rightfully earned the reputation as one of the most  
14 exciting teams in the nation; and
- 15 WHEREAS, team members Will Davis, Darrell Fisher, Terrence Hill, Israel Ingle, Georgy  
16 Joseph, Kenan Knight, Rey Luque, Kevin McDonald, Reggie McKoy, Taylor Patternson,  
17 Tobias Seldon, Cardale Talley, Justin Thompson, and Tommy Thompson have truly won the  
18 right to call themselves national champions; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the splendid performance of this fine team reflects the dedication of these young  
20 players and the special experience, knowledge, and training ability of Head Coach Tony  
21 Ingle and his staff.
