11 class for high school girls and, through the class's price of admission, was able to generate
12 funds for a local women's shelter; and

14 commitment to the scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently
15 conducted herself in a manner befitting the Gold Award; and

16 WHEREAS, in a world which seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the actions of
17 young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with particularity
18 the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.
