## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Thomas E. Shanahan and his service to the public; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, from 1992 to 2002, Thomas E. Shanahan followed in the footsteps of his father  
3 and faithfully served this state and its citizens as a five-term member of the Georgia House  
4 of Representatives; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Representative Shanahan was pivotal in securing funds for the construction of  
6 the Gordon County campus of the Coosa Valley Technical College and has greatly improved  
7 the community's resources and ability to receive a quality adult education; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he is responsible for assisting in securing funds for the acquisition and  
9 preservation of the Civil War battlefield in Resaca; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he served as a member of the 21st Century Voting Commission and was  
11 instrumental in the state's adoption, implementation, and modernization of a uniform and  
12 state-wide voting system; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he was committed to representing residents of the 10th District of the House of  
14 Representatives with genuine empathy, professional and honest attitudes, and openness and  
15 accessibility.

17 the members of this body recognize Thomas E. Shanahan and his great and dutiful service
