## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and remembering the great and joyous life of Shirley Lee Vick, Jr.; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, he was born in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, to his loving parents, Shirley Lee Vick  
4 and Edna Vick, on November 15, 1927; and

5 WHEREAS, he attended the Georgia Institute of Technology, but his college career was  
6 interrupted by his dutiful service to his country in the United States Navy during World War  
7 II; and

8 WHEREAS, upon the completion of the war, Mr. Vick finished his education at the  
9 University of Southern Mississippi; and

10 WHEREAS, following graduation, he began a career in insurance and was employed by the  
11 Coastal States Life Insurance Company; and

12 WHEREAS, he served as vice president of Louisiana and Southern Life Insurance Company  
13 and the Georgia International Life Insurance Company; and

14 WHEREAS, he founded his own company, Prepaid Benefit Services, and would remain there  
15 until his retirement; and

16 WHEREAS, he was a faithful and long-time parishioner of the Cathedral of Christ the King,  
17 a member of Holy Spirit Catholic Church, and worshiper at St. Anthony of Padua; and

18 WHEREAS, he was a valued member of the Knights of Columbus, Sons of the American  
19 Revolution, Sons of Confederate Veterans, the Southeastern Actuaries Club, and Cherokee  
20 Town and Country Club; and

1 WHEREAS, he is survived by his wife, Shirley Anne Crawford Vick; children, Lori Vick  
2 Millsap, Daniel Crawford Vick, and Amy Vick Green; and five glorious grandchildren.
