6 illegal drugs and in excess of \$589,000.00 in drug currency; and

accident victims and reducing the number of traffic related accidents by 28 percent; and

WHEREAS, the department has been recognized by the Governor's Office of HighwaySafety for its outstanding participation in the Click It or Ticket Program.
