A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Doraville police department; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Doraville police department, under the leadership of Police Chief John F.
3 King, has dedicated their department to protect and to serve the citizens and residents of
4 Doraville; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in the year 2003, the Doraville police department seized over \$4.3 million in
6 illegal drugs and in excess of \$589,000.00 in drug currency; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the department has taken the responsibility of patrolling the Interstate 285
8 corridor between Interstate 85 and Peachtree Industrial Blvd, providing first response to
9 accident victims and reducing the number of traffic related accidents by 28 percent; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in 2003, the department worked for safer streets by arresting over 412 drunk
11 drivers within the city limits and over 100 for driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol
12 on Interstate 285; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the department has been recognized by the Governor's Office of Highway
14 Safety for its outstanding participation in the Click It or Ticket Program.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
16 the members of this body commend the Doraville police department and Chief John F. King
17 for their service to the City of Doraville and the State of Georgia.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
19 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Chief John F. King.
