A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Annie Greene; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Annie Greene is one of Troup County's most distinguished citizens and one of
3 its most dedicated leaders; and

4 WHEREAS, she received a bachelor of science degree from Albany State College and a
5 master of arts degree in art education from New York University; and

6 WHEREAS, she was an art teacher with the Troup County school system until 1989 and
7 currently serves as artist and artist in residency for schools, libraries, professional
8 organizations, clubs, and mentoring programs; and

9 WHEREAS, she is a faithful and active member of the St. Paul A.M.E. Church where she
10 serves as the official board secretary, chairman of the commission on stewardship and
11 finance, trustee, and pianist; and

12 WHEREAS, included among the many community organizations to which she contributes
13 are the LaGrange Alumnae Chapter of the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., the LaGrange
14 Chapter of the Links, Inc., the Troup County Retired Teachers Association, the Georgia
15 Humanities Commission, the LaGrange Artist Guild, and the March of Dimes; and

16 WHEREAS, an artist of exceptional talent, her work has been displayed in 40 one woman
17 art shows since 1976, and in 116 group exhibits since 1962, and has received numerous
18 awards; and

19 WHEREAS, she is the devoted wife of Oliver N. Greene, Sr., and the proud mother of Zinta
20 Greene Perkins and Dr. Oliver N. Greene, Jr.

2 the members of this body honor Annie Greene as an outstanding citizen of the State of
3 Georgia and convey their immense appreciation for her service to the City of LaGrange and
